At Patrician Brothers' College, we offer personalised learning that recognises the particular needs of boys and young men in the pursuit of individual excellence.

We offer a well-rounded curriculum for junior students (Years 7 and 8) that includes Religious Education, English, Mathematics, Science, History, Geography, Music, Visual Arts, Technology & Applied Sciences, Food Technology, a choice of either French or Italian and Personal Development Health and Physical Education.

In addition to completing the core subjects, students in Years 9 and 10 have a wide range of academic, technical, creative and artistic electives.

Students in Years 11 and 12 have a broad selection of academic subjects and vocational educational courses (VET). There is also an opportunity to complete subjects from mainstream TAFE courses as part of HSC studies.

Our curriculum supports the integrated use of the latest multimedia technology to enhance learning. Students participate in a BYOD Program. The College has a comprehensive wireless network and all staff use the latest technology as part of teaching and learning.

The College also provides specialist programs for gifted and talented students as well as those with specific learning needs. Our Diverse Learning Team works closely with teaching staff to ensure programs of study for each subject meet the needs of the learner.

Our teaching staff regularly undertake professional learning to assist in developing innovative teaching practices and improve learning outcomes for all students.
